

## DRESS CODE– FEMALE STUDENT

*We want our students to wear their school uniform with pride and to project a positive image of themselves and of our school to members of the wider community.*

### Uniform

Complete school uniform must be worn to school each day as outlined in our guidance to parents. School skirts must be no shorter in length than the top of the knee cap and must not be altered in any way. Top buttons and ties must be done up properly. Ties must be worn to the top of the waistband. Girls may wear black opaque tights *or* black knee length socks. 'Slouch' socks are not permitted. Any garments worn underneath blouses must be plain white or cream.

### Blazers

All students must wear a school blazer at all times. Jumpers may be removed if preferred. 'Hoodies' or other items of non-regulation clothing must not be worn at any time while students are wearing school uniform.

### Jewellery

Each student may *only* wear the following items of jewellery: wrist watch & one pair of small, discreet gold, silver or diamante stud earrings - one to be worn in the lobe of each ear. No other piercings are permitted.

### Hairstyle

Hairstyles should be simple and of a natural colour. Unnatural colours like red, green, blue, purple are not permitted. Healthy & Safety considerations dictate that no beaded styles must be worn at any time.

### Make Up

Students may wear discreet (light) foundation to match their natural skin tone. Thick heavy make-up is not acceptable.

Eyeshadow, thick eyeliner or mascara are not permitted to be worn at any time during the school day.

Nails may *only* be painted with clear or 'French' manicure polish. Health & Safety considerations dictate that nails must be kept short. False nails or nail art are not permitted.

### Shoes

School shoes must be plain black in colour. Heels must not be higher than 5cm (2"). Canvas or trainer type shoes are not permitted. Parents should ensure that footwear is appropriate for all weather conditions.

## **DRESS CODE– MALE STUDENT**

*We want our students to wear their school uniform with pride and to project a positive image of themselves and of our school to members of the wider community.*

### Uniform

Complete school uniform must be worn to school each day as outlined in our guidance to parents. Top buttons and ties must be done up properly. Ties must be worn to the top of the waistband. Boys must wear black socks. Any garments worn underneath shirts must be plain white or cream.

### Blazers

All students must wear a school blazer at all times. Jumpers may be removed if preferred. 'Hoodies' or other items of non-regulation clothing must not be worn at any time while students are wearing school uniform.

### Jewellery

Each student may *only* wear a wrist watch. Piercings are not permitted.

### Hairstyle

Hairstyles should be simple and of a natural colour. Shaven or partly shaven hairstyles are not permitted. Hair should not be shorter than grade 2.

### Personal Grooming

All boys must be clean shaven at all times. Sixth form boys *only* are permitted to have facial hair.

### Shoes

School shoes must be black in colour. Canvas or trainer type shoes are not permitted. Parents should ensure that footwear is appropriate for all weather conditions.
