Dear Parent / Guardian

I am writing to you in order to clarify the examination and study leave arrangements for Year 11 external GCSE modular examinations. Year 11 students have GCSE examinations in the following subjects:

These examinations contribute to the pupils' final GCSE grades that the pupils will achieve in August 2025. The examinations start on the 8 May, and this is a stressful time for our students. However, it is important to find a balance between allowing students adequate preparation time for their examinations and minimizing the disruption to all their other subjects over this period of time. Therefore, the arrangements for this period are as follows:

- Study leave for Year 11 pupils (except for 11V2 pupils) on Tuesday 7 May and Wednesday
  8 May. No formal classes will be running apart from 11V2 lessons.
- At all other times pupils are allowed 1 day of study leave the day before they have an examination
- Pupils are allowed study leave in the morning if they have an examination in the afternoon
- At all other times pupils are expected to attend all lessons as normal e.g., pupils must return to class after a morning examination
- The normal teaching timetable will continue in classes (except for 7 & 8 May)
- Staff in all subjects have been instructed not to set normal homework for Year 11 pupils from Wednesday 8 May until Wednesday 22 May (revision homework for examination subjects may still be set)
- A study room (room 3) will be available for any pupil who cannot get home in between an exam / study leave session e.g. On Wednesday 8 May after the English exam pupils can leave to go home in order to revise for their LLW exam the next day.
