While the guidance offers a small range of options for schools to consider the general intent in the guidance is to restrict and reduce mobile phone access and ensure that pupils do not use their personal mobile phones or other similar devices, during the school day (this includes during break and lunch). We are in the process of finalising our new policy and this will be introduced early in the new year and issued to all parents. We are planning to implement a short transition period to allow our pupils to adjust to the new policy. Further information will follow at the start of the new term.
